ADMINISTRATIVE Agenda: The Boards reviewed the Agenda. Following review MATTERS and discussion, upon motion duly made by Director Groves, seconded by Director Kranse and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the agenda was approved.

2024 Budget Work Session:

Mr. Kasch explained the proposed 2024 budget in great detail. There was discussion around the General Fund, Capital Fund and Debt Service Fund. The Board requested that select General Fund Projects be accelerated. The team will incorporate Board comment and direction prior to the November 29th Budget Hearing.

Discussion about Holiday Lights: Mr. Kasch and Mr. Kenfield reviewed the current Bright View proposal for holiday lights at four entry monuments and the Ridge House. Alternative funding options were discussed. The board came to a consensus to proceed with the modified scope for Holiday Lights not to exceed \$20,000.

<u>District No. 9 Update:</u> Mr. Kasch gave a brief status update on the two District No. 9 Agreements and Resolutions and stated that there will be a complete update at the December 13th board meeting, following District No. 9 meetings and approval.

<u>ADJOURNMENT</u> There being no further business to come before the Boards, upon motion duly made by Director Groves, seconded by Director Meachum and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at 4:46 P.M.
